Chairperson of Church Council

I was faced health issues and surgery at the start of the year. Thankfully it was still fairly quiet, with all the COVID Guidelines in place. Starting in September we started to loosen our COVID Guidelines and implemented new guidelines to help keep our members safe.

We held our meeting over ZOOM and in person, when possible.

The Church Council had voted that all groups/meetings could restart.

Unfortunately, due to the pandemic we were unable to have our May Fest, Thanksgiving Dinner, or Christmas Bazaar, which are our fundraising activities. If you are still interested in supporting our community partners, such as our Church, Richmond Hill Food Bank, Evergreen Hospice, or the Yellow Brick House donations can be mailed in or you can use the envelopes on the left side of the shelf beside the church office.

We were able to reintroduce our Cake and Coffee Fellowship in the Church Hall following our services. It was great to see everyone being able to speed some much needed time catching up and socializing.

The Frohe Runde was also able to restart their meetings once a month.

In the Fall, the Lady's group met to discuss if the church should hold its annual Christmas Bazaar. Many of the women believed it was too soon to restart the Bazaar, and won't feel safe with so many people gathering.

I would like to thank all our members and friends who helped with the up keep of our Church and Property.

I would also like to thank all our Church Council members Edith Schiller, Edith Schulbeck, Monika Bos, Doris Lottermoser, Erin Tobin and Denis Jack for all their hard work and dedication to the church.

In October 2022, **all 7** Council Members **voted in favour** to start discussions regarding Terminating Pastor Peter. In October of 2022, we began discussions with Bishop Pryse's office, regarding our concerns and issues raised by numerous members. I spoke to his assistants Pastor Adam Snook and Pastor Doug Reble. Pastor Doug Reble was assigned to our Church Council for answering questions, advice, and guidance. We communicated with emails that all council members were involved in. This way all members were kept up to date.

I announced in church on January 15, 2023 that we had terminated the pastor's employment.

As per Bishop Michael Pryse, and his assistant Pastor Doug, we cannot discuss the individual complaints received from members or our reasons for termination.

This is why the Church Council terminated without cause according to his work agreement section 7a ii.

Once again I need to remind you all that we are not allowed to discuss individual examples of the Pastors behave or faults with our members.

Finance & Stewardship Committee

The Committee met twice in person and exchanged several emails throughout the year. Members in attendance for both meetings were: Edith Schiller, Erika Lottermoser, Olga Jürgeneit, and Annette Hinrichs-Pymm.

The committee met in February 2022 to discuss a \$100.000 bequest received for the church. All members recommended and then forwarded to council that

- \$50,000.00 (50%) goes to the Building Fund for future repairs and maintenance.
- The remaining \$ 50,000.00 (50%) go to the Regular Budget, out of which \$6,000.00 go to the following:
- i) \$5,000.00 (10%) to be used as Regular Benevolence and sent to the Synod
- ii) \$500.00 sent to Global Hunger
- iii) \$250.00 sent to Yellow Brick House
- iv) \$250.00 sent to Evergreen Hospice

This left a balance of \$44,000.00 that remained in the Regular Budget.

During the second in person meeting in November 2022, the committee compared the 2022 budget and the preliminary budget to the actual expense incurred to date and recommended that certain disbursements such as utilities, insurance, repairs & maintenance needed to be increased to reflect rising inflation and the cost of living. When submitting the proposed budget to council for approval the committee also recommended to raise the organist's pay by \$100 and noted that \$142,431 in disbursements and \$129,400 in receipts for the proposed 2023 budget will leave a significant shortfall of \$13,031.
